Annual Report. The permittee shall implement all measures necessary to achieve the flow restoration targets in the approved Flow Restoration Plan(s) no later than December 5, 2032.

Phosphorus Control Plan Reporting Deadlines

The permittee shall submit a report on an annual basis on the permittee's development and implementation of the Lake Champlain Phosphorus Control Plan (PCP). The PCP report shall be submitted every year on April 1 with the MS4 Annual Report.

Due Date	Compliance Item
March 26, 2024	Submit the Stormwater Management Program (SWMP) with the complete Phosphorus Control Plan (PCP)
No later than June 17, 2036	Complete full implementation of the approved PCP

Right to Appeal to the Environmental Court

Pursuant to 10 V.S.A. Chapter 220, any appeal of this decision must be filed with the clerk of the Environmental Court within 30 days of the date of the decision. The Notice of Appeal must specify the parties taking the appeal and the statutory provision under which each party claims party status; must designate the act or decision appealed from; must name the Environmental Court; and must be signed by the appellant or their attorney. In addition, the appeal must give the address or location and description of the property, project or facility with which the appeal is concerned and the name of the appellant or any permit involved in the appeal. The appellant must also serve a copy of the Notice of Appeal in accordance with Rule 5(b)(4)(B) of the Vermont Rules for Environmental Court Proceedings.
